Wow, I am almost forgot to send out an article for the newsletter. Robert wouldn't be surprised, but I made a lot of stink about being really early last time around. So, here I am listening to a concert on YouTube of my man crush. His first song is Nobody to Blame but Me. So, I better get this article out.

What's new in Road Captain land.... Well, we had our first road captain meeting of this year. We had a great turnout. The majority of the time we talked about the responsibilities of being a road captain, lead or sweep. To me, it really boils down to being able to solve a problem on the spot.....my GPS is wrong, now what, my route stopped, now what, the road is closed, now what? Below are a couple of bullets that we discussed:

General Guidelines for a Road Captain:

- Is expected to lead a group of riders in a safe manner until the final destination has been reached.
- Will execute his or her best judgement in situations not specifically covered in these guidelines.
- May change the route as actual road and/or weather conditions dictate or may cancel the ride when necessary.
- May instruct any rider to ride in a specific position within the group or to leave the group entirely for reasons of misconduct, disorderly or unsafe riding or for faulty or unsafe equipment.
- Will lead the ride at a pace that is appropriate for the riding abilities of the group, obeying all traffic laws.

We will be putting together an updated Road Captain Handbook with lots of good information for not only the road captains, but everyone.

Keep in mind that.....Road Captains share no responsibility or liability for actions of others that may be deemed irresponsible or occur due to inadequate rider skills. One of my other hot buttons is "knowing your group." Know the skill level of who is riding behind you as the lead or in front of you as the sweep. This is actually a very good habit for non-road captains to have as well. Who is in front of you that will stop at a red light, a stop sign?

Another item we discussed was about what we should carry with us, what is a proper set of tools? How about a fire extinguisher? How about a first aid kit? Some of us carry a list of ailments, medications, and other things we believe first responders, or our fellow riders need to know about us. I remember getting my first set of contact lenses and the optician telling me to make sure to carry a notice with me to let folks know I wear contacts. So, here you go, I wear contacts.

I hope you are glad to be receiving the GPX routes to all our rides, I post them on the Facebook page for the event, I email them to all active members from road captain email address, I also post them on my Harley Davidson profile. Then on top of things, Tony puts them in our Dropbox so that you can grab them via our website.

Ricky Skaggs just got introduced on stage, so it is time for me to close this down. I hope to see y'all on many future rides, and oh yeah, that mileage trophy this year, it's mine!

As of this writing it is March 2nd. The year is moving right along.

If you have not already noticed, we have a link on the Home Page for access to our database of .gpx routes. The button in the lower righthand corner labeled "Routes .GPX Files" takes you there. When you get to that page follow the instructions for downloading the file. Select a route for download to a stick and then from the stick transfer the file to your Harley GPS or Garmin device. Many of these routes were developed by Dave Stockton but as I loaded them, I noticed many other contributors from over the years from various HOG Members. Many are no longer members but it's something they left us as they move on. I renamed several of the files so that we can easily recognized the intended journey. I've ridden many of them.

Perhaps I'm a little eat up with technology and this is not intended to be a sales presentation but, I am a Garmin fan. When you see me on a ride, I'm probably running both the Garmin and the Harley GPS. On the latest model, Garmin Zumo XT, all you must do to share a route with your friends is pull up alongside another XT user, put it in "Share Mode" and transfer the route over to them without even getting off the bike. That feature and weather radar are the coolest features on the new Garmins.
